We are still hoping to run the postponed MJCT event sometime this summer. We have also booked the Canadian Deaf and Hard of Hearing Curling Championship for this October 9-12, assuming these types of gatherings are allowed by this time. As before, all decisions will be made as circumstances allow.

As mentioned in the April newsletter, we are looking forward to starting a U21 and U15 league running Sunday afternoons/evenings beginning September 13 to March 21<sup>st</sup>, 2021. If there is interest, we would also like to run a mixed doubles league (no age limit). There will be no curling on October 11, Thanksgiving weekend; no curling on November 29 due to the DEKALB SuperSpiel; no curling on December 27 or January 3; no curling on February 14, Louis Riel weekend. This will give the teams 20 plus games. The schedule will be flexible enough to accommodate teams competing in various events. Draw times would be about 4:00 for the U15 and 6:30 for the U21. (we are open to your comments on the timing of these draws.) Substitute teams are welcome when you can't make it. The fees would be \$600 per team plus GST. For any teams or players in any of the Morris CC leagues or CCTC programs the entry fee would be \$500 plus GST per team. We welcome your suggestions and input.

We now accepting new teams for the Practice Perfect Program which runs Tuesday evenings. This is a team based program for teams and their coaches to continue to build the players' technical skills as well as strengthen the team skills in all aspects of the game. Only 2 spots remaining.
